Scholar/Parent Agreement

****Scholastic Sports are a privilege not a right.****

Scholar Expectations

- Must have an updated Sports Physical
- Give effort, attention, right attitude and be respectful.
- Come prepared. Have the proper equipment required for training and competitions.
- Students are required to maintain a grade point average (GPA) of 2.5. If a scholar's GPA falls under a 2.5 on a report card, they will not be permitted to participate in competitions or practice until their GPA is at the expected rate. If the scholar's progress report does not reflect the anticipated GPA, they will be on probation until the scholar's GPA reflects the predicted rate.
- If a scholar misses more than half a day of school, they are not permitted to participate in training and or games on the same day. Athletes are scholars first. If scholar misses the day of a game, the scholar will not be able to play that day.
- If they receive a letter grade of an F, no matter the GPA will render a scholar ineligible.
- Scholars will conduct themselves as a representative of Wayne Preparatory Academy (WPA), both on and off the field.
- As long as you have the grades, you can play no more than two sports in a season.
- Athletic Director and Administration will not discuss playing time with the guardians. Playing time, Positions, Team Selections, etc. are determined by the head coach and his/her staff.
- If a student misses school, they can not participate in practice and games that day.
- Scholars are expected to attend all practices and competitions if selected.
- Three Absences is tardy.
- Ten absences are ineligible
- Sportsmanship is a high priority for WPA Scholars and the parents involved.
- Do not engage the other team's athletes, coaches, supporters or referees.
- If Scholar has ISS, they will not be able to participate in the next game.
- If a scholar receives OSS, they will not be able to participate in the next two games.
- If they receive OSS and ISS twice, they will be released from the team.
- Scholars will travel with the team on the bus to away games if provided by the coach. Scholars do not have to ride back on the bus if they have transportation by there guardian parents.

Coach Expectations

- Training; growth and development of team and individuals. Growth mindset; "where we are going over where we are at."
- Model good behavior
- Open door: email or other communication apps

Parent Expectations

- If parents/guardians have any issues with the coach/coaching staff with decisions made after training or competitions, a 24-hour rule should be adhered to.
- Chain of Command: Assistant Coach > Head Coach > Athletic Director (AD). The AD will take the situation higher if need be.
- #1 FAN: Be supportive, positive, and encouraging to all involved.
- “Before or After”; Do not influence what will happen, support/praise what has occurred.
- Praise effort over outcome.
- Parents and their families must pay to get in all athletic events. (Entrance fee goes to referees, jerseys, etc...)

Transportation

- Bus Transportation is \$375.00 per away game. The money is divide by the players on the team, majority of the time their are two teams splitting the cost. You can pay the whole thing at once or pay monthly. Everybody must agree on bus transportation, if you need help paying for transportation please let the coach know and he will talk to the athletic director.
- Parents will provide transportation unless school provides transportation for scholars to and from training and competitions. If a student is riding with another parent or guardian to a game/meet, their parents must send a letter to school with contact information. Guardians if you are willing to help with transportation, please let the coach know.
- Coaches are not allowed to provide transportation for scholars to and from games unless authorized from an administrator.
- Determine on time the AD or coach; they will release the scholars from class for games. Scholars will change in the locker room. Once they are changed in the locker room, parents will pick up the athlete from behind the gym. Parents will not need to come in and sign the scholars out unless the guardian is picking up the student-athlete before time. Early pick up will count against scholars absences/tardies. The coach or AD will bring a sign-out sheet for the parents outside.
